As a GAO intern, you will learn how to conduct federal audits and apply that knowledge as part of a team. Financial Auditors participate in a wide range of engagements with the overall objective of strengthening accountability for the Federal government's assets and operations.



In your position as an Intern you will:

- Assist in preparing, analyzing and interpreting accounting data.
- Develop accounting data to help draft recommendations to solve management problems or to restructure an organization.
- Prepare written summaries and draft written products as necessary for the use of senior financial auditors.

Requirements:

- You must be a United States citizen.
- Enrollment and good standing in an accredited undergraduate degree program
- Proof of intent to return to school in Fall or graduate during internship.
